The General Assembly voted for Burkina Faso to join AFSEC as Statutory Member starting from 2025, expanding AFSEC reach and influence.

Joint Committee between AFSEC and ARSO





The Joint Technical Committee in Renewable Energy between AFSEC and ARSO was endorsed with members from different African countries, whom will collaborate to develop standards in 3 areas of renewable energy via 3 subcommittees.



Adoption of Standards

The General Assembly approved the adoption of 99 standards and 4 Guides reviewed or developed by AFSEC Technical committees, ensuring the harmonization of electrotechnical practices across the continent.

New Technical Committees

The E-mobility Technical Committee was established to review Standards in Charging Stations and Electric Vehicles Components. While the Green Hydrogen Technical Committee was established to review Standards mainly in fuel cell technologies, hydrogen generators and storage devices.





Strategic Goals


The AFSEC Strategic Goals for 2025-2029 were approved, providing a roadmap to AFSEc future activities and goals for the next five years.
